In just seven and one half years the Love

INC movement in Littleton has grown from an idea, a board, and a half time executive director with a cell phone and a computer to the movement it is today.

Now, with six staff members in a larger office, a busy clearinghouse, and 11 gap ministries, we regularly mobilize hundreds volunteers from more than 29 churches. God has guided our path each step of the way opening hearts, minds, doors, and tearing down walls that often divide a community. Our work has focused on the things that unite us, connecting us with places God is already at work, while looking for gaps in services where the church can impact the community with service and love.

Throughout this time the key principle has been being intentionally relational, loving and Christian with every aspect of the ministry. When tasks before us seemed too overwhelming, we've broken big needs, big jobs, and big ministries into small manageable parts knowing God was always there to help us accomplish His work.

It's been an incredible journey for me, one that I would have never thought possible in such a short time. I've loved relating with our volunteers, pastors, leaders and clients.

Executive Director Search

Since Doug announced his retirement last week, the Board of Directors has started the search for his replacement. Transformational Ministry

Transformational ministry is about equipping people with essential life skills they need to be more self-sufficient, overcoming the challenges, pitfalls and problems they have chronically endured. This experience starts with Christ's love shared with each client participant through an trust relationship with a trained Love INC mentor in our Stepping Forward Program. Love INC is poised to take the next steps and is looking for people who want to actively engage in making this vision a reality. Carl Cleveland, the Transformational Ministry Coordinator, is forming a small development team to evaluate successful programs at other Love INC affiliates. Then we will identify and prioritize the elements of our Transformational Ministry, look at necessary resources, training, and support, and develop an implementation timeline. We will be sharing the vision with partner churches and learning about training already provided and encouraging facilitation of additional life skills training. Training will include financial management, parenting, healthy relationships, affordable nutrition, employment readiness, computer skills, Bible study and a variety of other life skills.

At the heart of this program are our mentors. Additional mentors will be recruited, trained in their role and continuously supported in their work with clients. Their task is to develop a trust relationship with their client, build a personal development plan with accountability, and coach that person, supporting them as they work through training classes and specific action plans. Full implementation will take time, hard work and many volunteers. 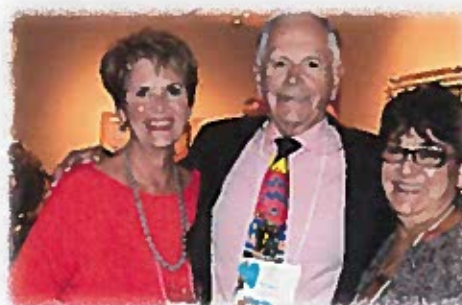
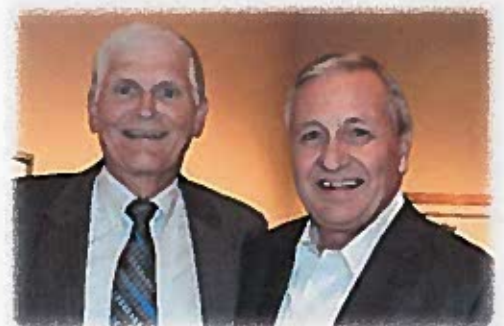
Celebrating Another Successful Empty Bowl
