ABOUT LOVE INC LITTLETON

Who We Are

We are a 501(c)3 non-profit Christian ministry located in Littleton and made up of a partnership of Christian Churches serving the south metro's individuals and families since 2008.

What We Do

Love In the Name of Christ (Love INC) seeks to be the eyes and ears in the community, while local Churches are the hands and feet. The local Church is God's answer to community brokenness and a part of His plan of redemption and restoration. That is why we engage local Churches to offer a holistic approach to caring for people in all areas of life: spiritual, mental, emotional, relational, material, and physical. Together, we are the body of Christ serving our community with love.

Love INC National

Love INC affiliates serve 115 communities around the country. Our Littleton Love INC has had the benefit of a national support system and a proven model of transformational ministry since 1977.



In 2022 Love INC National changed our logo to a blue heart and cross that includes a lattice design showing how we are *connectors* in compassion ministry. We help *build a framework* on which the community in need intersects with the local Body of Christ and finds transformation! We find the design also reflects our Volunteers who are the hearts and hands of Christ!

How We Work

We mobilize local Church volunteers to offer a holistic approach to caring for people in all areas of life: spiritual, emotional, relational, and physical.

The Love INC Process

Request - Our **CONNECTION CENTER** receives requests for help from area agencies, Churches, individuals, or families needing assistance and resources.

Assess & Verify – The nature, extent and legitimacy of the request is determined through an intake (over the phone) and calling of personal references.



Refer & Resource – The need may be served through a Love INC ministry or referred to a local Church or agency. Resources are provided through our Dipes 'n Wipes, Furnishing Hope, and Love on Wheels transportation ministries and the Connection Center provides vouchers for clothing and housewares at our resale store, RENEWED TREASURES.



Relationship – Those we serve are invited into more relational support and life transformation through the help of a volunteer **Navigator** or enrollment in our **IMPACT** ministry.

Follow-Up – We offer hope and encouragement through follow-up calls, prayer and continued support for new challenges.



Volunteer Transportation scheduler **Bob West** (St. Luke's UMC) connects Clients with our volunteer Drivers. Our drivers offer rides to multiple medical appointments and make sure many of our vulnerable and isolated seniors get to the care they need.

Volunteer Navigator Cynthia Dillon (Mission Hills) shared a big hug with her Navigation Client, Shanna. After multiple rounds of chemo, and working 3 jobs to care for 6 kids; she was able to problem-solve her finances with Cynthia's support.

The Impact of Community

Volunteer Navigator Leader Anne Heathman (Cherry Hills Community) invited her friend and neighbor Carla to join IMPACT. Carla was raised by grandparents and lived in a group home (after their deaths) and battled cancer at 18. After being widowed and surviving a fire in her apartment building; Carla had been struggling to make ends meet as a cleaning lady since her full-time live-in position ended. For almost a year, she had been staying with a friend and earning about \$500 -\$800 per month. When Carla started IMPACT, she was so shy, scared and nervous she could not eat dinner or speak in class until about week 3.

In the "Affirming Potential" class she was guided by facilitator, **Catherine Cordoue** (St. Frances Cabrini Catholic), and supported with coach, **Brett Pumphrey** (South Sub), and began to flourish in the class. By the end of 11 weeks, she was able to set a goal to grow her cleaning business and earn enough to be able to live independently. She has never owned a business, is not computer savvy, and has no experience in managing appointments, setting up a budget, or balancing a check book. However, through Catherine's instruction, Brett's coaching and Anne's navigation; Carla was able to build a business plan and is well on her way to being financially independent and able to rent her own apartment.
